

Privacy Notice for Insurance Service

Purpose for processing your information

To assess insurance claims made against the Council and to arrange insurance on behalf of leaseholders and Council tenants.

We collect the following information:

Name
Address
Date of Birth
National Insurance Number
Contact details including telephone number and e-mail address
Details of any other insurance in force
GP name and address (personal injury claims only)
Medical records (personal injury claims only)
Value of contents (for Tenant's Content Insurance Scheme only)

This information is only used for the intended purpose but if we intend to use it for any other purpose; we will normally ask you first. In some cases, the Council may use your information for another purpose if it has a legal duty to do so, to provide a complete service to you, to prevent and detect fraud, or if there is a risk of serious harm or threat to life.

How we collect your information

Information will be collected using different methods including by telephone, letter, claim form, e-mail, face-to-face and online form.

Information could be collected from:

Who the information is shared with

The information may be shared with the following:

How long do we keep your information?

Your rights and access to your information

You have the right to request a copy of the information that we hold about you.

The new General Data Protection Regulation also gives you additional rights about the information we hold about you and how we use it, including the right to:

- Withdraw consent and the right to object and restrict further processing of your data; however, this may affect service delivery to you.
- Request to have your data deleted where there is no compelling reason for its continued processing and provided that there are no legitimate grounds for retaining it.
- Request your data to be rectified if it is inaccurate or incomplete
- Have your data transferred or copied should you move to another authority
- Not be subject to automated decision-making including profiling
