

## 7. Harrow School Conservation Area, Harrow on the Hill

The Conservation Area was designated in 1968.

The Harrow School Conservation Area Appraisal and Management Strategy adopted in May 2008 as part of appendix 4 to the Harrow on the Hill Conservation Areas SPD.
