

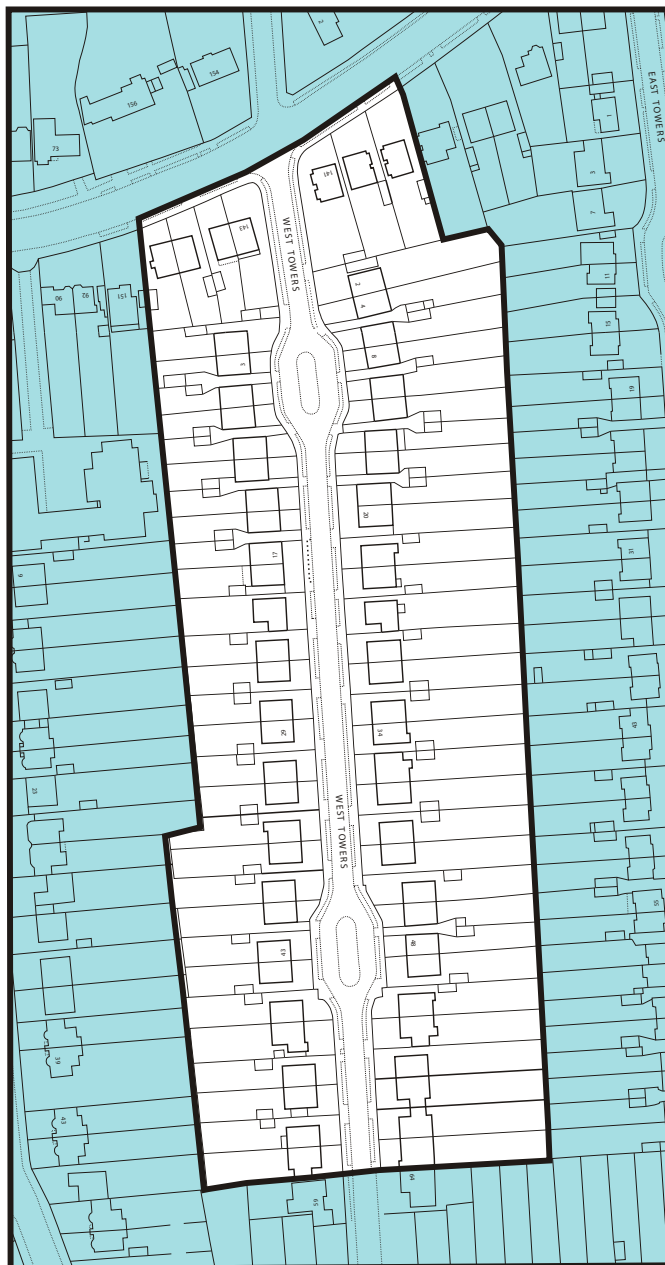
25. WEST TOWERS CONSERVATION AREA, PINNER.

Policy Statement: West Towers Conservation Area Appraisal and Management Strategy adopted in December 2009 as appendix 6 to the Pinner Conservation Areas SPD Designated in 1990.

Schedule of Properties:

Eastcote Road: 137 to 149 (odd).

West Towers: 1 to 57 (odd), 2 to 62 (even).

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THE WEST TOWERS CONSERVATION AREA ARTICLE 4 DIRECTION.

Confirmed by the Secretary of State for the Environment 10th June 1991.

Classes of permitted development controlled (made under the 1988 General Development Order):

Schedule II

Part 1 Class A: *The enlargement, improvement or alteration of a dwellinghouse.*
Class D: *The erection or construction of a porch outside any external door of a dwellinghouse of any property.*
Class H: *The installation, alteration or replacement of a microwave antenna on a dwellinghouse or within the curtilage of a dwellinghouse*

} only on front & exposed side elevations

Part 2 Class C: *The painting of the exterior of any building or work. (In relation to the exterior brickwork areas on the front and flank elevations of all properties within the CA).*

Confirmed by the Secretary of State on 23rd October 2003.

Classes of permitted development controlled (made under the 1995 General Permitted Development Order):

Part 1 Class C: *Any other alteration to the roof of a dwellinghouse (such as the insertion of rooflights or the alteration of roof tiles).*
