Statement of reasons:

The reduction in speed limit is expected to improve safety along Honeypot Lane for all road users.

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Harrow on 24 June 2024 made the above mentioned Order under section 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985 and all other enabling powers.
- 2. The general effect of the Order will be to amend the Harrow (Speed Limit) Traffic Order 2008 to revoke the 40 mile per hour speed limit in the northbound carriageway of Honeypot Lane between Balmoral House and a point opposite the common boundary of Nos. 466 and 468 Honeypot Lane. A 30 mile per hour speed limit will apply.
- 3. A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 8 July 2024, of a map of the relevant area and of relevant previous Orders can be inspected until the end of 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made at Greenhill Library, Perceval Square, College Road, Harrow, HA1 1GX between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. Monday to Saturday and 11.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. Sunday, excluding Bank Holidays, until the end of 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made.
- 4. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
