

SECTION 14(1)(a) ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 AS AMENDED BY THE
ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991



TEMPORARY WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS – GENERAL ELECTIONS

THE COUNCIL OF THE LONDON BOROUGH OF HARROW HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that they have made a Temporary Traffic Management order under the provisions of Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991. This is to facilitate the General Elections.

1. The order may be cited as The Harrow (General Elections) Temporary Traffic Order 2024, and shall be operational from 00:01hrs on 2nd July 2024 and shall remain in effect until 23:59hrs on 5th July 2024.
2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load at any time, when signs are in place on;
 - (a) Honeypot Lane slip road, between a point opposite the northern boundary wall of Nos. 320-336 Honeypot Lane and a point opposite the southern boundary wall of Nos. 320-336 Honeypot Lane;
 - (b) Shaftesbury Circle slip road, between a point opposite the extended eastern kerb-line of Shaftesbury Avenue and a point opposite the extended western kerb-line of Porlock Avenue.
 - (c) The Heights, the south side, between a point opposite the extended south-western kerb-line of Northolt Road and a point opposite the extended northern kerb-line of Gaylor Road.
3. Nothing in paragraph 2 above shall apply to:-
 - (a) any vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
 - (c) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to Section 66 or Section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
 - (d) any vehicles used in connection with the General Elections.
4. The provisions of the order shall not have effect unless all the signs in accordance with the provisions of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 are displayed, removed or covered, or unless at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.
