Statement of reasons:

"At Any Time" Waiting Restrictions have been introduced in College Avenue to improve safety by preventing vehicles from parking within the vicinity of a new pedestrian crossing.

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 1 July 2024 the London Borough of Harrow made the above mentioned Order under sections 6, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985 and all other enabling powers.
- 2. The general effect of the Order will be to introduce "At Any Time" Waiting Restrictions in certain lengths of College Avenue.
- 3. A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 15 July 2024, of a map of the relevant area and of relevant previous Orders can be inspected until the end of 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made at Greenhill Library, Perceval Square, College Road, Harrow, HA1 1GX between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. Monday to Saturday and 11.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. Sunday, excluding Bank Holidays, until the end of 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made.
- 4. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within 6 weeks of the date on which these Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
