

## SECTION 14(1)(a) ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 AS AMENDED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991

## TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - POTHOLE PRO 3

THE COUNCIL OF THE LONDON BOROUGH OF HARROW HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that they intend to make a Temporary Traffic Management order under the provisions of Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991. This is to facilitate carriageway repairs.

- 1. The order may be cited as The Harrow (Pothole Pro 3) Temporary Traffic Order 2024, and shall be operational between 08:00hrs and 17:00hrs on 9<sup>th</sup> September 2024 and shall remain in effect until 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2024 or until the completion of the works, whichever is the sooner. It is anticipated that all of the work should be complete by 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2024.
- 2. Vehicles shall be prohibited from entering or exiting the following roads, when signs are in place.

Please note, these dates are estimated dates and these may change. Advanced warning signs will be placed on site with accurate dates.

- 3. Nothing in paragraph 2 above shall apply to:-
  - (a) any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes;
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
  - (c) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to Section 66 or Section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
  - (d) any vehicles used in connection with the carriageway repairs;
  - (e) any vehicles needing to gain access to properties in the closed extents as far as is practicably possible.
- 5. The provisions of the order will not have effect unless all the signs in accordance with the provisions of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 are displayed, removed or covered, or unless at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.
- 6. Diversion routes:

Hawthorne Drive	via Lankers Drive, Church Drive and The Ridgeway and vice versa;
Church Drive	via Lankers Drive, Norwood Drive and The Ridgeway and vice versa;
Nelson Road	via Elm Park, Church Road and Marsh Lane and vice versa;
Exeter Road	via Capthorne Avenue, Lynton Road and Malvern Avenue and vice versa.
The Ridgeway	via Old Church Lane and Lansdowne Road and vice versa.
