### Statement of reasons:

Changes are proposed to introduce waiting restrictions on sections of Abbots Drive, Ashridge Gardens, Dudley Gardens, Fircroft Gardens, Flecker Close, Gyles Park, Harrow Fields Gardens, Holwell Place, Imperial Close, Kenton Park Crescent, Lamorna Grove, Leabank Close, Leighton Avenue, Malvern Avenue, Masefield Avenue, Mirren Close, Runnelfield, Shaldon Road, South Hill Avenue, Stiven Crescent, Stradbrook Close, Stratton Close and Sudbury Hill; and introduce "at any time" loading restrictions in locations within Stiven Crescent and Veldene Way.

#### This Order is being proposed for the following reasons:

- (a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, or
- (c) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), or
- (f) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs

In authorising the advertisement of these proposals, the Council has given consideration to its duty under s.122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians) and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on and off the highway (while having regard to the matters specified in s.122 subsection (2) of that Act).

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Harrow proposes to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and all other enabling powers.
- 2. The general effect of the Order would be to:
- (a) introduce double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions in locations within Abbots Drive, Ashridge Gardens, Dudley Gardens, Fircroft Gardens, Flecker Close, Gyles Park, Harrow Fields Gardens, Holwell Place, Imperial Close, Kenton Park Crescent, Lamorna Grove, Leabank Close, Leighton Avenue, Malvern Avenue, Masefield Avenue, Mirren Close, Runnelfield, Shaldon Road, South Hill Avenue, Stiven Crescent, Stradbrook Close, Stratton Close and Sudbury Hill; and
- (b) introduce "at any time" loading restrictions in locations within Stiven Crescent and Veldene Way.

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on \*\*\* and may be cited as The Harrow (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No.\*\*) Traffic Order 20\*\*.
- 2. - 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the Harrow (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Traffic Order 2014(c) shall have effect as though:
  - (a) for the items in Schedule 1 to that Order numbered 33, 293, 407, 422, 475, 488, 509, 529, 549, 586, 814, 832, 854, 860, 866 and 1073 there were substituted the items similarly numbered and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 1 to this Order;
  - (b) there were added to Schedule 1 to that Order the items numbered \*, \*, \*, \*, \*, \* and \* and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 2 to this Order; and
  - (c) there were added to Schedule 2 to that Order the items numbered \* and \* and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 3 to this Order.
