Statement of reasons:

Changes are proposed to increase the operational hours on Headstone Drive (from 8am – 6.30pm Monday – Saturday to 8am – 10pm Monday -Saturday, with a maximum stay of 3 hours) to allow more turnover of parking places. Hailsham Drive is proposed to allow on-street paid for parking for a limited period of time (2 hours maximum stay, 8am – 8pm, Monday - Saturday), to allow turnover and prevent all day parking, as well as changing existing "No Waiting" restrictions to "No Waiting at any time" restrictions. Roxborough Park is proposed to allow non-residents to pay to park in 2 locations that are currently only residents parking.

This Order is being proposed for the following reasons:

- (a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, or
- (c) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), or
- (f) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs

In authorising the advertisement of these proposals, the Council has given consideration to its duty under s.122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians) and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on and off the highway (while having regard to the matters specified in s.122 subsection (2) of that Act).

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Harrow proposes to make the above-mentioned Orders under Sections 6, 45, 46, 49,124 and Parts I to IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and all other enabling powers.
- 2. The general effect of the Order would be to introduce "At Any Time" Waiting Restrictions and paid for parking along parts of Hailsham Drive. To increase the operational hours of paid for parking on a section of Headstone Drive and to introduce "shared use" parking bays on 2 existing locations within Zone E1 (currently residents only parking) on Roxborough Park.
- 3. 




