Statement of reasons:

Changes are proposed to introduce waiting restrictions on sections of Penylan Place and Summit Close to improve safety and access. Also proposed is a new Permit Parking Area (PPA) restricting

both roads to residents only parking past this point between the hours of 8am and 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday.

This Order is being proposed for the following reasons:

(a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, or

(c) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), or

(f) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs

In authorising the advertisement of these proposals, the Council has given consideration to its duty under s.122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians) and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on and off the highway (while having regard to the matters specified in s.122 subsection (2) of that Act).

SCHEDULE **

SUMMIT CLOSE AND PENYLAN PLACE (ZONE SP)

PART 1 - INTERPRETATION

1. For the purposes of this Zone the following expressions shall have effect:

"permitted hours" in relation to a parking place listed in this Schedule means the period indicated in Parts 2 to 5, inclusive of Bank Holidays.

"resident permit restricted" will operate in this Zone.

"resident visitor permits" for this zone shall be valid for use in parking places listed in Part 2 to this schedule, during the permitted hours.

PART 2 - PERMIT PARKING PLACES (See Article 13)

TABLE 1 - PARKING PLACES

In relation to a parking place in this table the expression "permitted hours" means the period between 8am and 6.30pm on Monday to Saturday inclusive of any bank holidays falling on those days. Parking places in which a vehicle may be left during the "permitted hours" with a valid resident permit, business permit, trader's permit, resident visitor permit, carer's permit or Doctors permit for Area SP, or a valid health care permit.
