

SECTION 14(1)(a) ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 AS AMENDED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - CARRIAGEWAY RESURFACING NO. 6

THE COUNCIL OF THE LONDON BOROUGH OF HARROW HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that they intend to make a Temporary Traffic Management order under the provisions of Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991. This is to facilitate carriageway resurfacing works.

- 1. The order may be cited as The Harrow (Carriageway Resurfacing No.6) Temporary Traffic Order 2024, and shall be operational from 08:00hrs on 2nd December 2024 and shall remain in effect until 14th March 2025 or until the completion of the works, whichever is the sooner. It is anticipated that all of the work should be complete by 14th December 2024.
- 2. Vehicles shall be prohibited from entering or exiting the following roads, when signs are in place;

Pinner Road , between its junctions with Beresford Road and Somerset Road;	05/12/24 — 08/12/24 20.00-05.00
Broadfields, whole road;	06/12/24 — 07/12/24 08.00-17.00
Lynwood Close, whole road;	09/12/24 — 10/12/24 08.00-17.00
Parkside Way, between its junctions with Pinner View and Priory Way;	10/12/24 — 11/12/24 08.00-17.00
Kingsfield Road, whole road;	11/12/24 — 12/12/24 08.00-17.00
Lower Road , between its junction with Whitmore Road and a point opposite the northern boundary wall of Greville House.	12/12/24 – 14/12/24 20.00-05.00

- Nothing in paragraph 2 above shall apply to:-
 - (a) any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
 - (c) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to Section 66 or Section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

- (d) any vehicles used in connection with the carriageway resurfacing works;
- (e) any vehicles needing to gain access to properties in the closed extents as far as is practicably possible.
- 4. The provisions of the order will not have effect unless all the signs in accordance with the provisions of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 are displayed, removed or covered, or unless at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.

5. Diversion routes:

Pinner Road	via Bessborough Road, Lower Road, Shaftesbury Avenue, The Ridgeway and Imperial Drive and vice versa:
Parkside Way	via Pinner View and Kingsfield Avenue and vice versa;
Lower Road	via Bessborough Road, Lowlands Road, Tyburn Lane, Kenton Road, Watford Road, Sudbury Court Drive, Sudbury Hill, London Road, Harrow-on-the-hill and Roxeth Hill and vice versa.
