

**Notice of Making Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order**  
**Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 Section 53**  
**London Borough of Harrow**  
**1969 Definitive Map and Statement**  
**The London Borough of Harrow Definitive Map Modification Order 2024**  
**Tranche 1 (Urban Footpaths and Harrow Council's Land)**

The Order made on **05 December 2024** if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by adding to them: -

**UF150 A Footpath commencing at its junction with White Gate Gardens between Nos51 & 53 (Point A); proceeding south and turning west along the rear of Nos53-73, turning southwards along the western boundary of Weald Rise Junior, Infant and Nursery School; ending at its emergence with Robin Hood Drive between the school and the rear of Nos44 Chestnut Drive (Point B) with a width varying from 1.7m – 3.8m as shown on the map and with a centre line length of approximately 255m.**

Any representations about or objections to the Order must be sent in writing to the Infrastructure Team, PO Box 1358, Harrow, HA3 3QN or [infrastructure@harrow.gov.uk](mailto:infrastructure@harrow.gov.uk) no later than 03 February 2025 and applicants are required to state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made to the Order or any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, the London Borough of Harrow, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (or part of it if the authority has by notice to the Secretary of State so elected under paragraph 5 of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981) may itself confirm the Order as an unopposed Order or part of the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs in whole or in part for confirmation, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
