Statement of reasons:

The flat top road hump entry treatment is being proposed as a necessary safety measure under the Highways Act 1980 to reduce traffic speeds, protect pedestrians and cyclists, and manage traffic flow effectively. By implementing this measure, the highway authority seeks to fulfil its statutory duty to ensure the safety of road users, particularly in areas where pedestrian traffic is prevalent. The design and placement of the road hump has been carefully chosen to meet safety objectives while minimising disruption to the normal flow of traffic.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Harrow proposes to construct one flat top road hump raised treatment at Havelock Place's junction with Greenhill Way under the powers conferred by the Highways Act 1980, and under all other enabling powers.

Therefore, full carriageway width, kerb-high road humps are proposed at the following location.

(a) Havelock Place at its junction with Greenhill Way, with a length of 8.00 metres.
